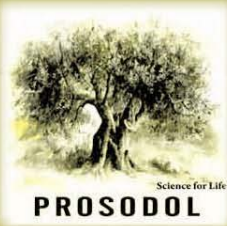

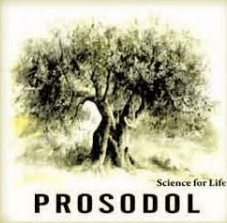

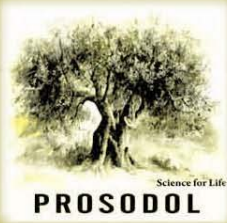

Wednesday 17 October

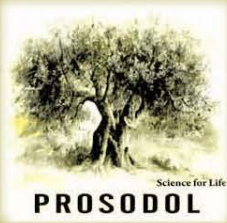
Scientific presentations in English and presentations in Greek targeted to mills' owners, local and regional authorities, farmers' associations, wider public.

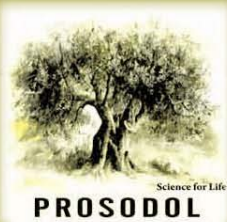

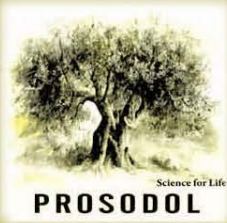

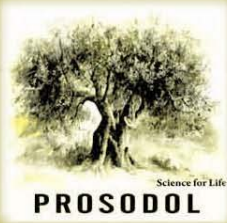
